A special meeting of the Gearhart City Council was held Wednesday May 27, 2020, online via Go-To-Meeting, using a computer, a tablet, or a smartphone. A MOTION by Councilor Jesse, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilor Cockrum for the second reading of ordinance #926 imposing taxes for the city, by title only, MOTION was approved 5-0. Chad Sweet read ordinance #926 by title only.

A MOTION by Councilor Jesse, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilor Fackerell for the second reading of Ordinance #927 imposing taxes for the road district, by title only, MOTION was approved 5-0. Chad Sweet read ordinance #927 by title only.

A MOTION by Councilor Fackerell, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilor Smith for the second reading of ordinance # 928 fixing compensation for city officials, by title only, MOTION was approved 5-0. Chad Sweet read ordinance #928 by title only.

Mayor Brown advised the resolution extending workers compensation to volunteers, which was resolution #948 that we adopted last meeting, will need to be rescinded. We will need to take a look at the wording and put it on a future agenda. ON MOTION by Councilor Smith, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilor Fackerell to rescind resolution #948, MOTION was approved 5-0.
