Special Meeting of the City Council Tuesday, November 9, 2021 6:00 p.m. On-site and Virtual via Zoom

The special meeting of the Gearhart City Council was called to order on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at 6:01 p.m. by Mayor Cockrum. Present were Councilor Warren, Councilor Jesse, Councilor Smith, Mayor Cockrum, City Administrator Chad Sweet and Executive Assistant Krysti Ficker.

There was no conflict of interest declared by any member of Council.

No Council reports were given, correspondence reviewed, or public testimony taken.

The purpose of the meeting was to interview attending Interim Fire Chief Josh Como for the official Fire Chief position.
