ORDINANCE NO. 921

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF GEARHART: CITY ATTORNEY, CHIEF OF POLICE, FIRE CHIEF, AUDITOR, TREASURER, AND JUDGE, AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THESE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF GEARHART.

The City of Gearhart does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That all prior Ordinances fixing the compensation of the City Attorney, Chief of Police, Fire Chief, Auditor, Treasurer and Judge of the City of Gearhart and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. The City Attorney of the City of Gearhart shall be paid a rate of \$215.00 per hour on a as needed basis.

Section 3. That the compensation of the Chief of Police of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of 81,475.29 per year. The compensation of the Fire Chief of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of 80,495.08 per year.

Section 4. That the compensation of the auditor /city administrator position of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$91,047.75 per year to be paid from the General Fund Administration.

Section 5. That the compensation of the Treasurer of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$53,114 88 per year, to be paid 23,901.70 from the Water Fund, \$29,213.18 from the General Fund Administration.

Section 6. That the compensation of the Judge of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$250.00 per hour.

Section 7. That in as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Gearhart in order that the City may function and provide water services, legal service, police protection, health protection and have its financial and business affairs taken care of for the benefit of the people of the City, which cannot be done unless payment is made for such services, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 1st day of July, 2019, after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
