Subject - New Business - Gearhart Clean Up Day

Synopsis: In honor of Earth Day 2020 (4/22), City staff is requesting permission to hold the Gearhart FREE Clean Up Day on Saturday, April 25, 2020. As in past years, staff proposes Recology deliver to the area in front of City Hall -- (4) 20-yard drop boxes for trash and (1) 3-yard drop box for recycling electronics. The boxes would be available for residents of Gearhart to dump trash at no cost from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Council Options:

- 1) Council resolves to allow Gearhart Clean Up Day;
- 2) Take other action desired by the Council;
- 3) Do nothing.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Councilors resolve to allow the City to hold the clean up day to reduce the amount of trash in the City, and/or improper disposal of electronics.

Legal Analysis: None

Financial Analysis: The estimate from Recology for the dump day is not available at this time as the employee who handles is currently out of the office. Historically, Recology donates a discount on top of the initial cost - last year's total was \$880. The City also covers the cost of one Public Works employee to monitor the dump boxes and assist residents.
