

## **Staff Report**

For City Council Meeting - 11/4/2020

Subject - Ordinances/Resolutions - Resolution #952 Budget Category Transfer  $\rightarrow$  Hazard Mitigation Fund

**Synopsis:** At the July City Council meeting, Staff requested up to \$22,000 from the Hazard Mitigation Fund to finish purchasing specified grant-funded items for the mass care cache. The fund will be replenished through grant funds awarded from FEMA through OEM's State Homeland Security Program (SHSP). The request was approved, the items purchased, and reimbursement from the State is on the way. In order to replenish the \$21,662 in hazard mitigation funds, a budget category transfer needs to be done via the attached Resolution #952.

## **Council Options:**

- Resolve to transfer \$21,662 in grant funding from the general fund to the hazard mitigation fund as specified in the attached resolution upon deposit of reimbursement funds;
- 2) Do nothing.

**Recommended Motion:** Staff recommends the Council resolve to transfer the funds as described in Resolution# 952.
