

RESOLUTION #969

A RESOLUTION GRANTING BUDGET APPROPRIATION TRANSFERS

WHEREAS, the City of Gearhart adopted Resolution #958 adopting and making appropriations for 2021-2022 budget on June 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gearhart's actual expenditures have varied from the budgeted anticipated expenditures, which requires an appropriation transfer between existing categories; and

WHEREAS, explanations for the needed transfers within the City of Gearhart's budget appropriations for 2021-2022 include: a more accurate distribution calculation in the City's annual insurance premium; compensation for a newly created staffing position in the building department; compensation for conflagration in the fire department; and, an adjustment in public works labor salary distribution in the parks department and Water fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEARHART, that budgeted monies within the General Fund be appropriated per the "Adjusted" column in the chart below:
