Lewis & Clark Timberlands values and respects the neighbors and communities surrounding our timberlands. We are certified by an independent third-party Sustainable Forest Management Standard (brochure enclosed) and believe in environmentally responsible forest management. As active supporters of the community, we are committed to making our neighbors aware and understanding of the scope of upcoming management activities.

This letter is to inform you that we have scheduled a pre-commercial thinning operation near or adjacent to your property. Pre-commercial thinning is the cutting of small trees which are overcrowding young forests. This improves forest health by allowing the cut stems to cycle back into the forest floor. We welcome your questions or concerns; however, no response is necessary. This operation is scheduled to occur sometime between November 2023 to December 2023. The location is identified by the following legal description:

Section 15 Township 5 North, Range 8 West

Forestry operations can be interesting to observe, but it is always important to keep a safe distance. Please take the appropriate precautions so that neither people nor pets venture into active operation areas.
