



## **RESOLUTION NO. 992**

### **A RESOLUTION FOR AN ADVISORY SUPPORT TO GAUGE SUPPORT FOR A NEW PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING DOWNTOWN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gearhart wishes to gauge voters support for Public safety facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, understanding Gearhart voter's preferences for location and amenities of a future Public Safety building will aid in the City's planning efforts.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the City Council instructs the City Administrator to transmit the below Ballot Title to the County Clerk and take all other actions required by Oregon Revised Statutes.

#### **BALLOT TITLE:**

Advisory Vote Gauging Support for a New Public Safety Building Downtown

#### **Question:**

Would you support a new public safety building in downtown Gearhart to house police and fire first responders?

#### **Summary (175 word max)**

The City's current fire station is an un-reinforced concrete block building, built in 1958. It is at an elevation of 27 feet. The City would like to gauge whether there is public support to construct a new building, for firefighters and police officers, as well as the preferred location for that building, and amenities. This advisory vote question is to gauge whether the preferred location is approximately the same place as the current fire station. A vote of yes is a non-binding indication that you support the building of a new building and that you would like that building to be located in historic downtown Gearhart.
