Gearhart Preparedness

Recommendations:

- 1. 'Preparedness Committee' established.
- 2. Hire disaster specialist / team to advise city on evacution routes, assembly areas and other preparedness measures, inundation/landslide/liquefaction, and help make a plan that leads to a successful grant request to FEMA.
- 3. Hire Grant writer for FEMA application.
- 4. Increase Community Outreach/discussion/education program.
- 5. Coordination woutside groups: MJNHMP, State, County, other N Coast cities.
- 6. Prepare a revised Evacuation Map/Plan, revised Assembly Areas
- Decentralized with increased number of Assembly Areas
 (likely to be accessible after an M9/L1 event within 15 minute [.75 mile] walk)
- Two Assembly Area options from every spot in Gearhart.
- Assess Water Tower Assembly Area for landslide, tank structure, and access.
- Signage at Assembly Areas coordinate with Evac Map. Change nomenclature eliminate 'optional' and 'temporary' and call assembly areas perhaps 'preferred' 'alternate' or just 'assembly area'
- Revise Evac Map in coordination w DOGAMI.
- Consider $8.1/2 \times 11$ that can be easily revised.
- 7. Supply all revised Assembly Areas with water, food, shelter, medical supplies, communications, etc.
- **8.** Backpack/Go Bag program to get backpacks for a high percentage of houses/residents/visitors. Premade backpacks that can be purchased in or near Gearhart.
- **9.** Write Grant for FEMA funding after plan is established to help find optimal assembly area configuration especially evacuation towers.
