### Tips for Coexisting With Roosevelt Elk in Gearhart:

-  Be aware of your surroundings and avoid walking into the middle of an elk herd.
-  Enjoy watching from a distance.
-  Keep pets on a leash at all times.
-  Elk are most active at dawn and dusk, but avoid human and pet conflicts at all times especially during September/October (breeding season) and May/June when calves are born.
-  Non-native vegetation attracts elk. To move a herd off of your property, calmly approach the herd making your presence obvious. Avoid surprising or being aggressive towards any wildlife.
