- ~Ensure that all City Commissions, Councils, and Committees represent the wide diversity of views and interests in the community.
- ~To conserve, preserve, and protect open space, scenic areas, historic and natural resources in and around the Gearhart community for future generations.
- ~Support tsunami preparedness and related resilience efforts.

- ~Encourage further development of recreational facilities and create a master parks and trails plan.
- ~Ensure a stable and healthy economy.
- ~Promote the conservation, development of alternative sources, and the efficient use of energy.
- ~Ensure decent, affordable housing and housing availability.
- ~To provide water serviceand adequate drainage within the city.
- ~Encourage efforts of recycling by area residents and businesses.
- ~Establish the City as the primary authority for making land use decisions with the City's Urban Growth Boundary.
- ~Maintain all identified marsh/wetland/ riparian areas in their natural and productive conditions.
- ~Transportation system to include connectivity for walking and biking.
